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

Pregnant Students





Pregnancy Related Services (PRS) and Special Education Services are support systems, including Compensatory Education Home instruction (CEHI) that a student is entitled to receive during the pregnancy prenatal and postpartum periods to help her adjust academically, mentally, and physically and stay in school. These services are delivered to a student when:

- The student is pregnant and attending classes on a district campus,
- A valid medical necessity for confinement during the pregnancy prenatal period prevents the student from attending classes on a district campus, or

- A valid medical necessity for confinement during the pregnancy postpartum period prevents the student from attending classes on a district campus.
- \* A pregnant special education student's Admission Review and Dismissal (ARD) committee and PRS program staff must collaboratively address the student's service needs.

The district will offer CEHI services, (2 hours) as well as special education services (4 hours), as part of the student's program. See 9.12 PRS and Special Education Services (SPED).

## Contingency Admission Review and Dismissal Meeting (ARD)

## Documentation Needed:

- \* A Medical Request for Home Instruction Services and/or Special Education Services Due to Complications of Pregnancy...needs to be filled out by a licensed medical practitioner.
- ❖ It should state a medical necessity for confinement that requires the student to remain at home and specify the length of prenatal/post partum confinement.
  - When a student is ready to return back to school, the student's physician completes a release to return to school form.
